

## Mrs Rae of Westerton

32 bar Strathspey for 3 couple set.  
Suggested music - The Silver Star

- 1 - 4 W1 sets to M3, they change places RH  
5 - 8 M1 sets to W3, they change places LH.  
9 - 12 W2 & M3 set and turn BH WHILE  
M2 and W1 set and turn BH  
13 - 16 W2 and M1 set and turn BH  $\frac{3}{4}$  WHILE  
M2 and W3 set and turn BH  $\frac{3}{4}$ , 2s are now b-b on 1<sup>st</sup> diagonal  
17 - 24 Passing the dancer facing RSh,  $\frac{1}{2}$  diagonal Reel of 4  
2s pass Rsh to partner then another  $\frac{1}{2}$  diagonal Reel of 4  
with those in 2<sup>nd</sup> corner positions.  
ALL ARE NOW IN ORIGINAL PLACES  
25 - 28 1s  $\frac{1}{2}$  turn BH, keep NHJ dance down to 2<sup>nd</sup> place, middle  
while 2s step up on 27 & 28  
29 - 32 1s  $\frac{1}{2}$  turn both hands, cast out and down to 3<sup>rd</sup> place while  
3s step in and up on 31 & 32.
